# Newland Bridge - Update / Facebook Questionnaire feedback

An email from A. Smith to a resident of Snaith was circulated to council members at the meeting. The Town Clerk advised 3 minor road accidents had taken place since the Newland Bridge Closure and this was thought to be due to lack of area knowledge by drivers. Cllr. J. Barrett advised ERYC were continuing to assess the situation regarding traffic in the area. Cllr. J. Hollas advised he had noted some congestion at tea time around Puntons Shop but this is to be expected. Cllr. R. McArthur stated vehicles were continuing to travel down the one way system the wrong way and that better signage on the floor was required. Cllr. J. Staveley – Churton advised he believed the council should now be pushing for all the new speed limits to be permanent. Cllr. J. Staveley – Churton proposed writing to ERYC asking for the School roads to be 20mph seconded Cllr. R. Lyons and agreed.
