Cllr. J. Barrett advised he had attended the planning meeting in Beverly to object to a Gowdall Planning application however this had now been approved.

Cllr. J. Barrett advised Mrs Hird had received the Goole and Selby Citizen of the Year Award for her continued work on Snaith and Cowick Heritage Day.

Cllr. J. Barrett advised work would hopefully start in the near future at Park Lodge Shooting School to continue to build the Bunds.

Town Clerks Report

Replies from East Riding of Yorkshire Council

106 Agreement – Harron Homes

A letter from ERYC was circulated to council members prior to the meeting. Cllr. G. Hulme proposed a letter be sent to ERYC asking them for the funds they will receive from Harron Homes from the 106 Agreement which could then be used for the residents of Snaith as well as asking what equipment will be installed in the play park seconded Cllr. D. Butterfield and agreed

Various Requests

A letter from ERYC was circulated to council members prior to the meeting. Cllr. D. Hill stated she was unhappy with the reply and wished to question the response.

Zebra Crossing – Selby Road

Cllr. D. Hill proposed advising ERYC the section of road close to Puntons store was a natural slowing point and a crossing was needed to allow all residents from the North East area of Snaith to cross the road safely seconded Cllr. D. Butterfield

East Cowick - Parking

It was agreed Councillors take photos of parked vehicles close to the crossing and forward to the Town Clerk

Cllr. J. Barrett proposed contacting ERYC asking them to keep the traffic lights in their current location but to have them covered up as originally requested seconded Cllr. G. Hulme

Cowick Road

Cllr. D. Hill stated she was very unhappy with this section of the response and that the road needed a safe crossing point as well as speed reduction enforcement especially with the new development and children crossing for school Cllr. D. Hill proposed contacting ERYC and challenging their response seconded Cllr. S. Jones and agreed

Street Naming

An email was circulated to council members prior to the meeting. The Town Clerk advised ERYC were happy with the names however would have to change Tom Johnson Way to Johnson Way. This was now going to Harron homes for final approval. Noted by Council Members. Cllr. D. Hill advised there was a Manor Farm Estate in Carlton and to inform ERYC

One Way Survey

The Town Clerk gave initial figures with regards to returns from the one way survey. The Town Clerk advised a full breakdown of the result would be given to councillors in the New Year. Noted by council members

Market Place Parking

A copy of a letter from a concerned resident was circulated to council members prior to the meeting. Cllr. J. Barrett proposed writing to the resident advising them to contact ERYC as this was a matter for ERYC Traffic and Parking team seconded Cllr. D. Butterfield and agreed

Parking behind Priory Church

The Town Clerk advised a resident had contacted the council regarding the land between the railway line and the highway on Priory Way and requested if this land could be made available for parking. Cllr. G. Hulme proposed contacting Network Rail asking them if this was possible and what is the legal distance required between track and highway seconded Cllr. D. Butterfield and agreed

Request for Bin on Cadman Lane

The Clerk advised a resident had requested a bin be placed on Cadman Lane. Cllr. G. Hulme proposed contacting Russ Acaster at ERYC to ask if they would empty a bin this far from the public highway seconded Cllr. D. Hill and agreed

Cycle Access – Buttle Lane / George Street – Cllr. D. Hill



Cllr. D. Hill advised vehicles were parking at the junction of George Street and Buttle Lane where cycles were supposed to gain access however this was not possible due to the parked vehicles. Cllr. D. Hill proposed writing to ERYC asking for the law and guidelines on Cycle access seconded Cllr. D. Butterfield and agreed

Reducing Speeding HGV's – Cllr. S. Jones

Cllr. S. Jones expressed concern over speeding vehicles including HGV's and Agricultural vehicles from Rawcliffe through to Hensall. It was agreed to liaise with neighbouring parishes in the New Year to discuss the best course of action. Noted

Recent Planning – Vets. Market Place

The Town Clerk informed councillors the property on market Place may not have gained the correct Planning consent and this was been investigated by Hazel Walsh at ERYC. Noted by council members

Rospa Report

A full report for both play areas was shown to council members with the minor issues raised explained to council members. Cllr. S. Jones proposed purchasing the buffer required for the gate at the Joint Use Play Area seconded Cllr. D. Butterfield and agreed

Information was given to councillors regarding possible future plans with regards to setting of precepts for Town and Parish Councils. Noted by council members

Christmas Market


The Town Clerk asked all councillors if they were available for the Christmas Market Event on the 3rd December. ALL councillors advised they would be available
