Notification of work in Snaith and West Cowick

I'm writing to let you know that we're about to start some investigation work ahead of a project we hope to start later this year to improve the clean water network in your area

From Monday 15th February our contract partner Morrison Utility Services will be carrying out this work on our behalf, working hours will be Monday to Friday 8am until 5pm and it should take around 2 weeks to complete.

This work involves digging trial holes in the road to check the ground conditions and the location and depth of other utilities. All areas will be restored when we've finished.

The work will be completed in 2 sections, I've enclosed plans showing where we'll be working in red, the dates and any traffic management. I hope you find these useful.

This work won't affect your water supply and we won't need access to your property; please always remember to ask for identification before letting anyone into your home.

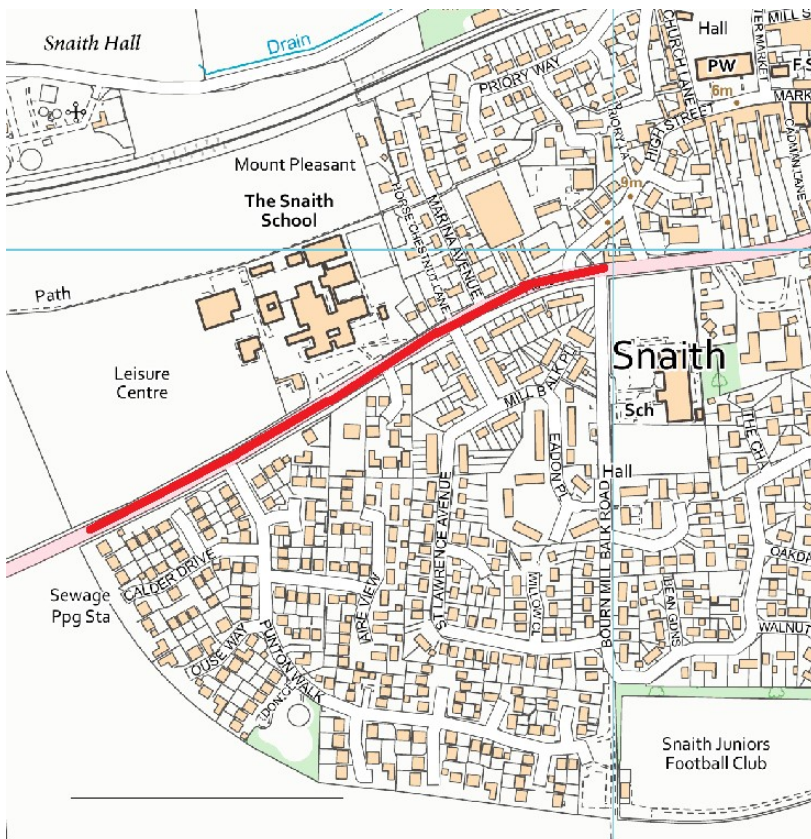

15th-19th February- Pontefract Road

We'll need to complete 4 trial holes on this section of road.

For safety reasons we'll need to use temporary traffic lights around our working area. They will be manned during peak hours and will move as our work progresses.

Each trial hole will be restored before we move onto the next location.



22nd-26th February

2 trial holes will be completed on Butt Lane and a further 2 on Main Street.

We'll use priority boards to safely control traffic around our working area.

Access to driveways will be maintained and each trial hole will be restored before we move onto the next location.
