Snaith & Cowick Town Council previously objected to this development based on the following;

- a. Any need for social/affordable housing in our area is currently being met by other major housing developments within the vicinity of the site, namely the Harron Homes site on Cowick Road, the Kings Reach development by Lovell's on Butt Lane and the proposed site by Bellway Homes off Pontefract Road.
- b. This application is OUTSIDE the development line for West Cowick.
- c. The proposal does not meet the criteria of Policy SD4 of the East Riding Local Plan
- d. The proposed development is not in keeping with the aesthetical character of existing properties along Grange Road
- e. A concerns that the proposed 2x passing places will be used as on-street parking.

These reasons remain applicable and the Town Council continue to object to this proposal.
